### Fee Structure

### Access to the Studio

Members are able to use the studio at any time, including evenings and weekends.  
Access is by entry code.

### Participation

Membership includes a requirement to roster on for one studio cleaning session per year.  
Members may also be invited to participate in fundraising activities and working bees.  
Social events will be held from time to time for members to meet up with each other.

**We are a not-for-profit organisation run by volunteers; therefore the facilities do not cater for commercial use of the studio or our kilns; the kilns cannot be used for commercial loads / large quantities of work by one member in relation to others. We will not fire the work of members who do not attend the studio or participate in the general running of the pottery.**

The Studio and Gallery are part of the Mullumbimby District Cultural Centre and is leased from the Council. As such we must comply with any Health Orders that are in place.

\* Kiln Firing fees are calculated after each firing by item weight(s) according to the standard rate(s) and costs are deducted from members' advance kiln fee. When the balance of a member's kiln fee account balance falls below \$10, a request is sent to 'top up their account'.

Members' kiln fees that are not expended during the year will be carried forward to the next year. If the member does not rejoin, the kiln fee will be refunded on request. If no refund request is made by the member for six months, fees will not be refunded. Kiln fees are not transferable to another member. Members may request their own updated figures at any time, by contacting the Treasurer.
